When was the British Indian Ocean Territory established? Formerly administered as part of the British Crown Colony of Mauritius, the British Indian Ocean Territory (BIOT) was established as an overseas territory of the UK in 1965. A number of the islands of the territory were later transferred to the Seychelles when it attained independence in 1976.



How many islands are in the British Indian Ocean territory? Map of the British Indian Ocean Territory since 1976. The territory is an archipelago of 58 islands covering 56 square kilometres (22 sq mi). The largest island is Diego Garcia, which at 32.5 square kilometres (12.5 sq mi) accounts for about half of the territory's total land area.

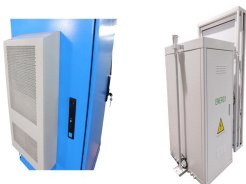

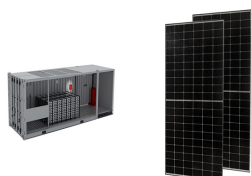
The British Indian Ocean Territory marine protected area in the north, which the UK declared in 2010, is highly valued by scientists from many countries. They consider it to be a global reference site for marine conservation in an ocean that is heavily overfished.



On Thursday 3 October, my right hon. and learned Friend the Prime Minister and Mauritian Prime Minister Jugnauth made an historic announcement: after two years of negotiations and decades of disagreement, the United Kingdom and Mauritius have reached a political agreement on the future of the British Indian Ocean Territory.

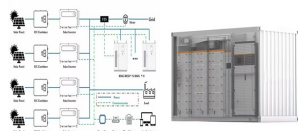

The British Indian Ocean Territory has some of the most biodiverse waters on the planet with over 220 species coral, 855 species of fish and 355 species of molluscs. To ensure the future protection of this unique environment the BIOT Commissioner declared a 640,000 km² "no-take" (where all commercial fishing and extractive activities are prohibited) Marine Protected Area on ???

The government also broke down development figures for other scales of solar, particularly 1-5MW rooftop solar which is expected to be developed at \$73/MWh by 2020, and sub-10kW rooftop or residential solar, which is expected to have a LCOE of \$128/MWh by the same year, equivalent to 12.8p/kWh.

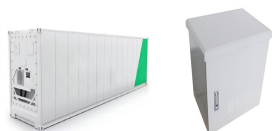

On 3rd October, the UK Government announced an agreement to cede sovereignty of the British Indian Ocean Territory (BIOT) ??? otherwise known as the Chagos archipelago ??? to Mauritius. This decision has aroused considerable debate from across the political spectrum, and beyond British shores.
