



What ETA caliber is c01.211? The ETA caliber C01.211 is a 15 jewelsautomatic chronograph movement made by ETA mainly for Tissot,but also Certina. Both brands are part of the Swatch Group conglomerate of Swiss watch companies. Interestingly,Tissot did not apply their own caliber designation to this movement.



How does a c01.211 chronograph work? The C01.211 movement uses a column wheelto control the start,stop,and reset functions of the chronograph,resulting in accurate and smooth operation. The movement also features a quick-set date function and a frequency of 28,800 vibrations per hour.



What is a calibre c01.211? Calibre C01.211 is an inexpensive automatic chronograph movementmade by ETA for Tissot since 2008. The Lemania 5100 was a legendary workhorse of a movement, constructed from stamped steel, delrin plastic, and other simple materials.



How big is a c01.211 watch? With a diameter of 30mmand a height of 7.9mm,the movement is compatible with watches that have a case size of 41-43mm. The C01.211 movement uses a column wheel to control the start,stop,and reset functions of the chronograph,resulting in accurate and smooth operation.



What's new in ETA c01.211? ETA created this Cal. C01.211 based on the Lemania 5100 design. It was simplified and re-worked to be more attractive, with plates and bridges finished in a more refined manner. Additionally, jewel count was reduced to 15, operation slowed to 21,600 A/h, and the minute counter was moved to the 12:00 position.



Is the c01.211 a rare movement? The only negatives I have about the c01.211 is that it should've carried over the 28,800 BPH and it should've kept the chrono minute hand on as a large hand as well. But,that's only minimal. As long it proves itself over time,then it might be a rare



movementjust like it's cousin; the 5100.





But the 5100 lives on. Sort of. ETA makes the 2009 C01.211 movement that has some very strong genetic links to it indeed. But this ain"t progress. There's no central minute counter ??? one of the most useful features of the 5100. The jewel count is down from 17 to 15 jewels too. You"ll find it in the Tissot PRC, Couturier and a few Swatches.

So now I sent the watch back again and was offered my moneys back in full plus shipping. now I have kinda lost confidence in this relatively NEW ETA C01.211 Movement. AND whats worse, is I"m down a watch and I am forced to either buy the pro version with the Valjoux 7750 movement, or choose another brand altogether. pretty much a bummer for me :-(

I"ve got the PRC200 with the ETA c01.211 movement, which is based off the Lemania 5100, as all the talk reveals. To be honest, I have a co-worker that has a PRC 100 with the 7750 movement (model: T008.414.11.051.00) and I"ve worn it and used it a lot. I don"t really care for the 7750, because it doesn"t seem as well constructed as the c01.211.



Maybe, there is a way to get the broken movement to work again. I will be looking into that. Any input is welcome. The buttons on the new movement are much smoother and easy to operate. The other one had a serious problem out of the box, I guess. So, that is my experience with the C01.211 movement
