While the landscape of government support for solar panel installations has evolved with several past programs phasing out, there are still viable options available to assist UK households in adopting solar energy. Key among these are the Energy Company Obligation (ECO4), Local Authority (LA) programs and the Home Upgrade Grant (HUG).



Another grant you can avail of for solar panel installation is the UK government's Energy Company Obligation Scheme (a.k.a ECO4 scheme). This grant for solar panels was launched last April 2022, replacing the ECO3, and will run until March 2026. The Green Deal is one of the solar panel grants previously led by the government. Community Solar Panel Grants. Community solar panel projects are growing in size and in popularity as communities can earn money through investing in large scale solar projects. There are also a number of solar panel grants designed to help communities install solar and other renewables but most are available locally through local or regional



In the past, government schemes in the UK offered free solar panel installations to eligible households. However, as of 2021, there are no longer any government grants or schemes that offer completely free solar panels. However, some options are still available that can help reduce the cost of solar panel installation.
