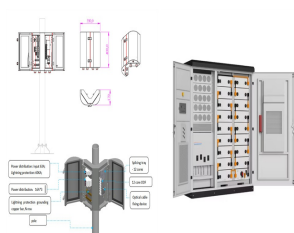

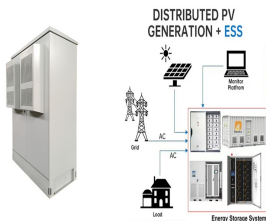

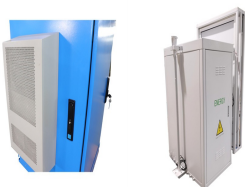

Communities anywhere within the service area of California utility Pacific Gas & Electric (PG& E) will now be eligible to apply for support to install renewable-plus-storage microgrids. In April this year, PG& E, one of the state's big three investor-owned utilities (IOUs), rolled out the Community Microgrid Enablement Program (CMEP). The



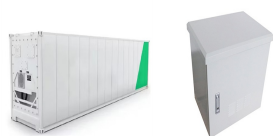
PG& E has developed a comprehensive process that includes a Community Microgrid Enablement Tariff, Microgrid Operating Agreement, Microgrid Islanding Study, Community Microgrid Enablement Program, Microgrid Incentive Program, Community Microgrid Technical Best Practices Guide, dedicated microgrid staff, and more. Each community microgrid is unique, and is designed by the community to address their specific goals and needs for the project. A range of variables will dictate the size of the microgrid, what community services are served and what elements are included in the design. The diagram above represents an approximate layout of a community microgrid.

1.4.2. Phase 2: Microgrid Incentive Program . On April 6, 2023, the Commission adopted D.23-04-034 which establishes rules for the Commission's Microgrid Incentive Program. The Microgrid Incentive Program is a program that places community microgrids in disadvantaged, vulnerable communities to support populations impacted by grid outages.

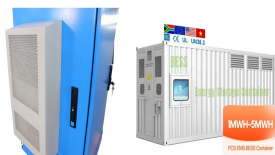
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The Redwood Coast Airport Microgrid project is a community-driven microgrid. It is powered by third-party owned solar and battery energy storage. It is funded by the Redwood Coast Authority, Schatz Energy Research Center and PG& E's Community Microgrid Enablement Program.

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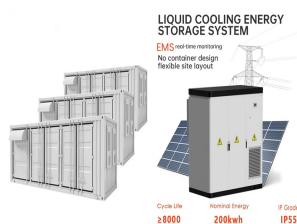
