

EAST TIMOR ENERGY STORAGE PROJECT



Is East Timor interested in solar power? East Timor President Jos? What are the barriers to the CCS project offshore East Timor? Robertson said there were several barriers to the CCS project offshore East Timor, also known as Timor Leste, proceeding. Including, firstly, a long and expensive pipeline will need to be built to ship the carbon dioxide (CO₂) from Barossa or the LNG facility in Darwin, northern Australia, to Bayu Undan.



What will East Timor do with the Bayu Undan CCS hub? Ultimately, East Timor hopes to generate a storage fee and acquire carbon credits for the proposed Bayu Undan CCS hub.

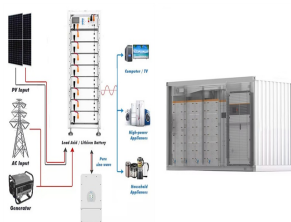
