Who owns the Falklands? As a British overseas territory, the Falklands have internal self-governance, but the United Kingdomtakes responsibility for their defence and foreign affairs. The capital and largest settlement is Stanley on East Falkland. The islands are believed to have been uninhabited prior to European discovery in the 17th century.



In January 1851 a company was formed for the purchase of Lafones" rights and interests in the islands, and on 24 April 1851 a preliminary meeting of The Falkland Islands Company was held. The Falkland Islands Company has been in operation for over 160 years and dates back to the mid-1800s, where the company was granted a Royal Charter to Trade by Queen Victoria on 10???


Over the course of January in Falkland Islands, the length of the day is rapidly decreasing om the start to the end of the month, the length of the day decreases by 1 hour, 15 minutes, implying an average daily decrease of 2 minutes, 31 seconds, and weekly decrease of 17 minutes, 34 seconds.. The shortest day of the month is January 31, with 15 hours, 20 minutes of daylight ???
