
How do you store a battery? You need deionized water for the final rinse. Polypropylene or polyethylene is OK if it is food grade. etc,etc In short,top up your batteries with some sane charger and leave them in the basement. Or wherever. Colder is better as long as it is not below,say,-5C. Most batteries survive a year or two with this storage strategy.
