Dubbed the Nkonge solar power project near the Kabamba military barracks, its construction has been undertaken by Xsabo Group (a Germany-based company), which has invested over Shs 63 billion.

Xsabo Nkonge Solarline, a \$17 million 20 MW solar power plant in Mubende district, will be commissioned before 31st March 2024, the company's Chief Executive Officer, Dr. David Alobo, has revealed. He was speaking in Mubende at a function where Uganda Development Bank (UDB), the project's financier, released their 2023 performance.

To help diversify the national energy pool for Uganda, The Xsabo Group is developing five solar parks in various locations within the country, with total generation capacity of 150 MW (200,000 hp). The Kabulasoke solar power plant is the first to be developed by the company, thus the name "Pilot Solar Power Park Kabulasoke" as stated in its license.



On September 28, 2020, Xsabo Group received a 21-year, three-month license to construct and operate this 20-megawatt solar plant in Kyakasa village, Kasambya sub-county, Mubende district. Dr David Alobo, the founder and managing director of Xsabo Group, elaborated on the plant's innovative features. It is equipped with 38,000 bifacial panels



Ugandan developer Xsabo Group has launched construction of a 25MW solar park at Kabulasoke in the central district of Gomba. Vice-president Edward Ssekandi laid the first of the 68,000 modules in a ceremony on 3 October.
