



How to save home assistant backups on Nas? To be able to save our Home Assistant backups on our NAS, we must first mount the corresponding directory in our Home Assistant. This can be done under ???Settings???- > ???System??? -> ???Storage??? -> ???Add Network Storage??? Fill out the form and click on Connect. To have the backup created automatically, we create an automation.



What backup options are available for home assistant? Regular backups are crucial to protect your configuration, automations and integrations from data loss. This article introduces various backup options for Home Assistant, including the use of network-attached storage (NAS), the Google Drive backup plugin and virtual machine (VM) backupwhen Home Assistant is virtualized as a VM.



Where should a home assistant backup be located? Of course, the backup location must be placed on the NAS mountthat has just been created. A very popular method for Home Assistant backups is the Google Drive Backup plugin. This add-on automatically synchronizes your Home Assistant backups with your Google Drive account. It offers a simple and reliable solution for backing up your data off-site.



Should I store backups outside of home assistant? Storing backups outside of Home Assistant makes sure they don???t use space on Home Assistant to begin with. It also makes sure you can restore Home Assistant from backup in case you have an issue with your current installation.



Does home assistant support network mounted storage? As of Home Assistant Core 2023.6,Network Mounted Storage is supported for addons. Keeping the current data is optional,but the data will need to be moved regardless so the share can be created successfully. As of Home Assistant Core 2023.6,Network Mounted Storage is supported for addons.





How do I expand my home assistant storage? When you are running Home Assistant Operating System, you can use the following options to expand your storage: Replace your current storage medium, for example, the SD card, with a bigger one. Use a backup to restore Home Assistant from backup on the new SD card.



By default, Home Assistant records everything in the database. If you don"t need that much history, then don"t record it. (See Recorder Integration). Also, if you don"t need the history, you can safely delete the database (home-assistant_v2.db). Home Assistant will start a new one and when it fills up your storage, you can delete it again.

The Frigate integration can be easily installed via HACS (Home Assistant Community Store). Follow these steps: Navigate to HACS in Home Assistant: Go to Home Assistant > HACS > Integrations. Click on Explore & Add Integrations and search for Frigate. After installation, restart Home Assistant to apply the changes. Configure the integration:



When you restart home assistant as the last part of step #6, frigate should now be storing media (recordings, clips, snapshots) on your external drive. You can check this by looking at the drive ???

The main culprit of failed Home Assistant installs on a RPi: The SD Card. About 2 years ago, I wrote a widely popular article for Optimizing your Home Assistant Database in order to combat this to a degree, by filtering any entities you don't need recorded from the database. This process still holds value and is applicable even today, although things have gotten much ???





Apparently there are now three frontend modes, storage, auto-gen, and yaml.
