Where are the Turks and Caicos Islands located? The Turks and Caicos Islands (abbreviated TCI; /??t???rks /and /??ke??k??s,- ko??s,- k??s /) are a British Overseas Territory consisting of the larger Caicos Islands and smaller Turks Islands,two groups of tropical islands in the Lucayan Archipelago of the Atlantic Ocean and northern West Indies.



Are Turks & Caicos a self governing territory? The Turks and Caicos Islands participate in the Caribbean Development Bank, is an associate in CARICOM, a member of the Universal Postal Union and maintains an Interpol sub-bureau. The United Nations Special Committee on Decolonization includes the territory on the United Nations list of non-self-governing territories.



Who serves the Catholic Church in Turks & Caicos? Catholics are served by the Mission Sui Iurisfor Turks and Caicos, which was erected in 1984 with territory taken from the then Diocese of Nassau.





What are the natural resources of Turks and Caicos? The primary natural resources are spiny lobster, conch, and other shellfish. Turks and Caicos contains three terrestrial ecoregions: Bahamian dry forests, Bahamian pineyards, and Bahamian-Antillean mangroves. The two distinct island groups are separated by the Turks Island Passage.




