

Built for the Salt Lake 2002 Olympic Winter Games, Utah Olympic Park is located in Park City, just 25 miles east of Salt Lake City, Utah. The nearly 400 acre venue houses one of only four sliding tracks in North America, six Nordic ski jumps, a 2002 Winter Games museum, and a multitude of adventure activities.



The International Olympic Committee on Wednesday awarded the 2034 Winter Olympics to Salt Lake City, putting the capital city and the wider Games region into the starting gate of what will be a course to the opening ceremonies that will help define the next decade of Park City history and influence the trajectory of the community into the middle of the century.





EnerDel, a leader in utility-scale lithium-ion battery energy storage systems, was contracted in 2010 to supply backup power for the substations that support the XXII Olympic Winter Games.
