




How much electricity does Zimbabwe generate? Zimbabwe relies heavily on hydro-powered resources to generate electricity. As per the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA), Zimbabwe generated around 7 TWhof electricity in 2021 via hydro-powered resources, accounting for 58.2 % of the total electricity generated in the country.





Currently, Zimbabwe faces daily load-shedding of up to 16 hours, with businesses incurring heavy costs by relying on generators. Large corporations have reported spending up to US\$300 000 per month on fuel, further driving up production costs.. The cost of using alternative energy sources is about 50% higher than conventional electricity.
